The assessment of the final years will be mainly by formative workplace-based assessments and primarily through the CBD, PBA and MSF. For each module there will be specific PBAs at each skill level. There are existing DOPS which have been mapped to basic level as well as PBAs. The CBD will be used for discussion around complex management planning particularly in the context of the multidisciplinary team. Trainees will be able to undertake reflective learning exercises that will count towards their portfolio evidence. Evidence from these assessments will also inform the summative assessment by the AES and the ARCP.

A quality indicator for the evaluation of training posts is that they must be able to provide the trainee with the opportunity to undertake 40 workplace-based assessments per year (approximately 1 per week).
