

#### MCR demo step by step guide

This step-by-step guide is provided to assist you in navigating the multiple consultant report (MCR) demo / Trainee self-assessment demo that is now available through your ISCP user account.

**IMPORTANT:** Please note this is only a demo and any data generated through this process will not be saved on the ISCP system or impact trainee portfolios.

MCR demo works best on the most recent versions of the following browsers: Google chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge. Please make sure your browser is up-to-date.

**IMPORTANT:** Please made sure you disable any ad-blocker add-ons before using the online MCR form.

#### **1. Navigate and start report**

- Log in to your account on ISCP.
- Go to link: <u>https://www.iscp.ac.uk/mcr</u>

**IMPORTANT:** Make sure you log into your user account before accessing the MCR link.

- Non-trainees only (i.e. if you are an AES, CS, TPD etc.): select the trainee you want to create a report for
- All users: select 'create MCR'.

### 2. Complete an MCR report / trainee self-assessment

### GPCs

- On the first page, you will access the Generic Professional Capabilities (GPCs). There are 9 GPCs in total.
- For each GPC, 'Appropriate for stage' is the default rating. You can alternatively select 'Areas for development'.
- If you select 'Areas for development,' then feedback shall be required. You can add free text in the comments box. You can also select descriptors (from the Descriptors box.

# CIPs

- On the second page of the MCR report, there are capabilities in practice (CiPs), five CiPs in total.
- Select a supervision level for each CiP (between levels I to V) with level IV being 'Able and trusted to act unsupervised' and level V being 'Performs beyond the level expected of a day one consultant'.
- If you give a CiP a level III or lower then feedback is required. Like the GPCs, it is possible to add free text or select descriptors from the descriptors box but your choice of descriptors is limited to five for focus during the next 3-6 months.
- As well as 'Areas for development', it is possible to show where performance has been excellent.

- It is possible to navigate back to the GPCs by selecting 'Back to edit GPCs'
- Once you have finished adding supervision levels and feedback to each CiP then select 'save and finish'.

### 3. MCR summary and printing report

- The final page of the MCR is a summary report of all feedback given in relation to each GPC and CiP.
- It is possible to print the completed MCR report using the green print button.
